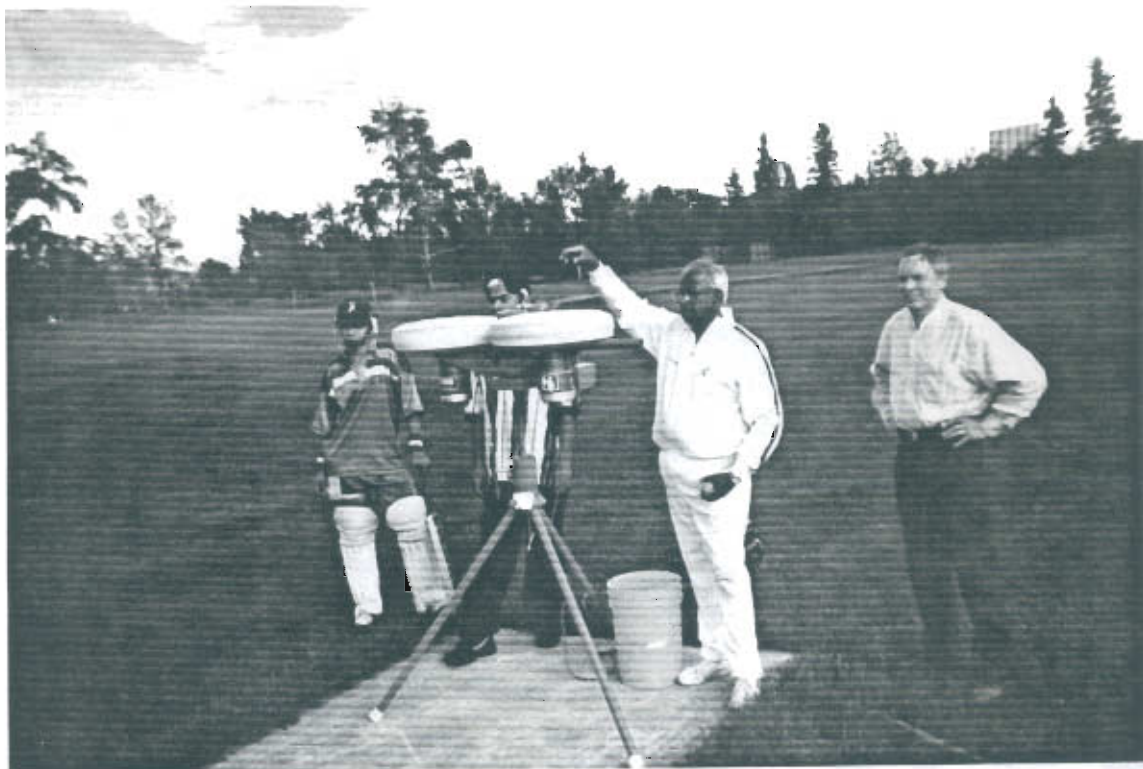

Was placed 6th in line of 11 clubs. This was a tremendous effort by the Juniors in their first appearance in first class club cricket competition. The Junior team would have achieved great heights if more support was received from the District Executives and the cricketing circle.

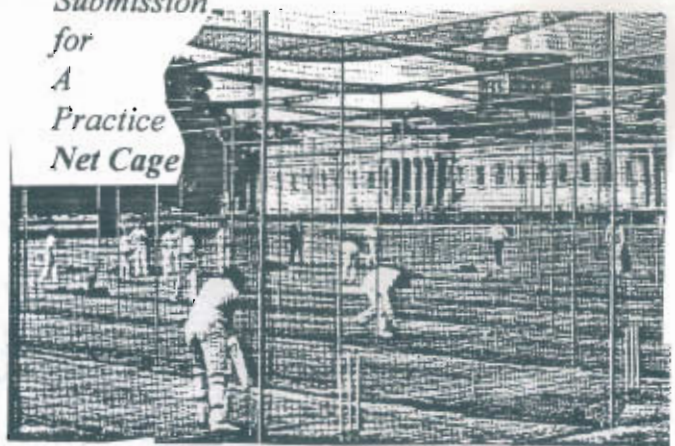

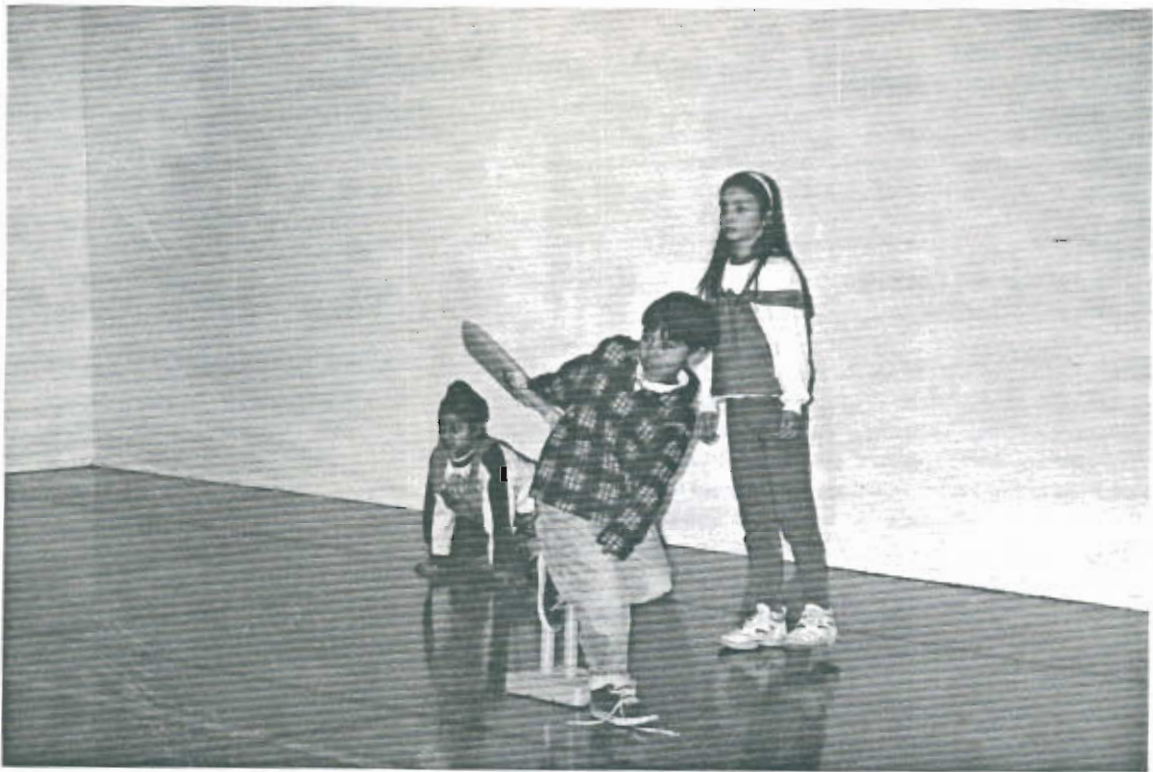
