Cricket Development Officer & Coach Report - 2003

The Alberta Schools Cricket Association was formed in 1995 with a view to introducing and developing the sport of cricket among Albertan students. Within this eight years this organization has been the main source providing elite youth cricketers into the club stream, inter-city, provincial, national & inter-national levels. The ASCA therefore can be said to be a feeder strength and so fulfils a vital obligation.

The Cricket Development Officer & Head Coach of ASCA is also the Provincial Cricket Coach & Coaching Coordinator of the ACA. The International Cricket Council ICC Americas regional award for Best Junior/Development Initiative 2003 was presented to the Alberta Schools Cricket Association.

The Jack Kyle Development Canadian Cricket Association CCA 2003 award was presented to the writer for outstanding achievement, which fostered the growth & development of cricket in Canada.

Schools Cricket

Indoor coaching continues at Fere Antoine School Gymnasium from January to June for 18U & Holy Cross School Gymnasium for 15U. Thanks to Bryn Whittaker & Jitendra Patel for their support & assistance in coaching. Outdoor games were conducted at Coronation Park in July/August. The schools indoor kangaball cricket tournament was held on the 1st November 2003 at J.Percy Page High School Millwoods. The schools physical education class, lunch break & after school coaching continues from March to Nov.

Calgary & District Schools Cricket Coaching program

In June 2003 visited Red Deer & Calgary Schools & two days at Riley Park. Calgary has an excellent junior program in place they have three stages of coaching U11, U14 & U18. A special word of thanks goes to Junior Coordinator Mukul Ahuja and coaches Spenser, Duncan & Neville for their efforts.

President's Message - 2003

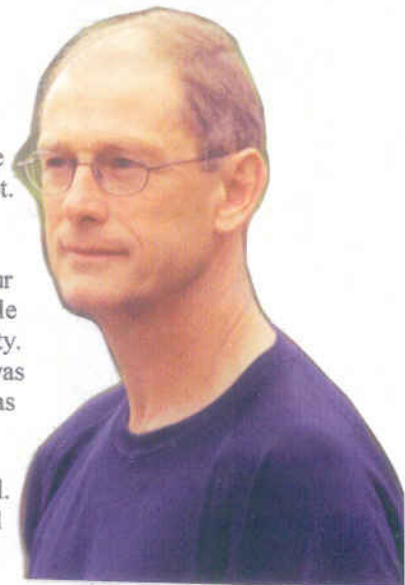

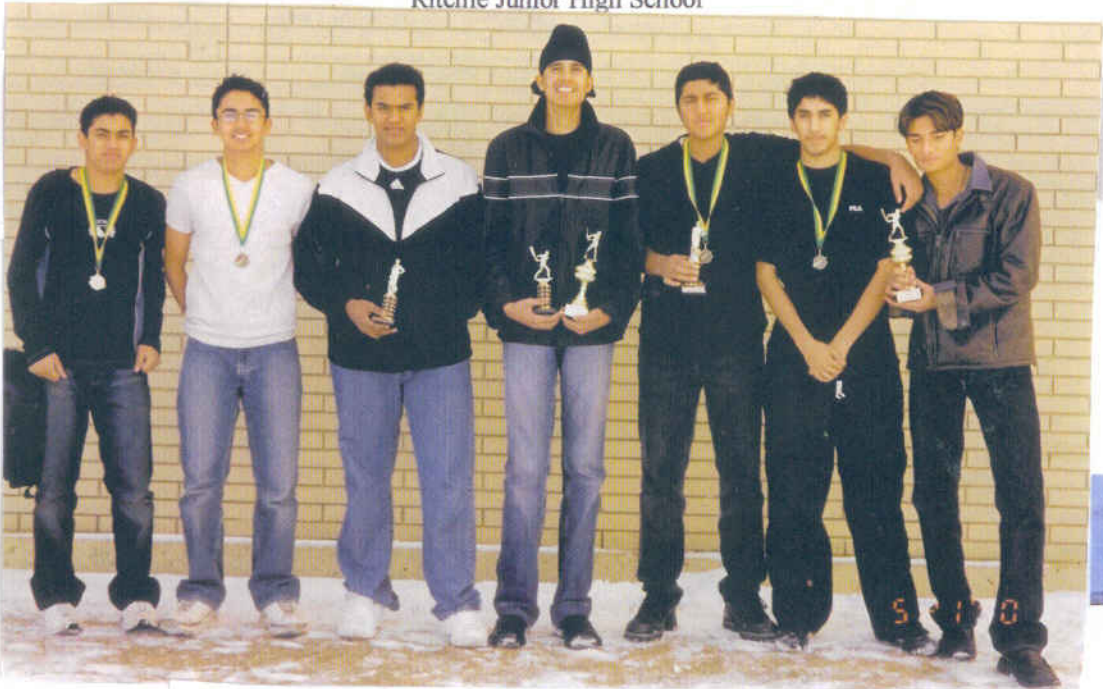
